AARP Driver Safety Program

AARP Driver Safety Program is the largest classroom driver refresher course specifically designed for motorists who are 50 and older! This eight-hour course is taught in two, four-hour sessions over a two-day period and is offered **Wednesdays, July 2 & 9 and August 6 & 13**, from **9:00 am to 1:00 pm in Room D**. *Preregistration is a must.* There is a \$10 per person fee with checks (ONLY) made payable to AARP. *Ask your insurance agent about automobile insurance discounts.*
